Ontario's Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA) makes health and safety awareness training mandatory for every Ontario worker by July 1, 2014.

New Ontario Government regulations require every worker in Ontario to complete health and safety awareness training. This training ensures that both workers and employers understand their rights and obligations under the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA).

Complete the Training Online

The online learning module - *Worker Health and Safety Awareness in 4 Steps*, takes 45 – 60 minutes to complete and can be found at:

Participants receive a "Proof of Completion" certificate upon completion of the online training. This certificate will be required for all work in Ontario, once the regulation comes into full force on July 1, 2014.

The completed and signed manual serves as your proof of completion.

Before reporting to work, performers should be prepared to submit proof of completion to production upon request.

Please complete either the online training module, or printed pdf at your earliest convenience.

The deadline for completion of training is July 1, 2014.

Important:

The online training module does not track your progress. To get your certificate, you must complete the training in one sitting.

Print and save the certificate before exiting the online training module, and before closing your internet browser.

Keep a copy of the 'proof of completion' certificate, or completed manual for your own records.

The Ministry of Labour will not store this information, or keep a record of training.
